Production Size Chart

Record finished garment measurements, not body measurements. Fill in the base size first, then the other sizes. Points A to J suit most tops; replace or add rows for your garment.

A	Body length	From high point of shoulder, straight down to hem							
B	Half chest	Edge to edge, 2.5 cm below armhole							
C	Half waist	Edge to edge, at the narrowest point							
D	Half hem	Edge to edge, along the bottom							
E	Shoulder width	Shoulder point to shoulder point, across the back							
F	Sleeve length	From shoulder point to end of cuff							
G	Half bicep	Edge to edge, 2.5 cm below armhole							
H	Cuff opening	Edge to edge, at the end of the sleeve							
I	Neck width	Across the neck opening, seam to seam							
J	Front neck drop	From shoulder line down to front neck

Measure flat. Garment on a table, closed, smooth but not stretched.

Half or full. Widths here are edge to edge, so half the circumference.

One version. Update the version and date after every fitting change.
